Sixth-form students have required class activities May 23 - 25. Sixth-formers rowing in the crew regatta will have additional responsibilities through May 27. Sixth-form boarding students may take a "weekend" starting on May 25 until May 28, but are not required to leave campus before graduation. All sixth-form boarding students must be in the dorms the night of May 28 and are expected to move out by 3 p.m. following Prize Day. Graduates are not allowed to return to campus for any reason (this includes access to facilities and driving current students) before June 3.

Parents will then be reimbursed.

Buyback for third-, fourth- and fifth-formers is June 2 from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. in the Student Center. Students not graduating will be credited 5 percent of their total sold to Follett toward future purchases of books for the fall semester.
