Departure evening of 7/6

Day One

- Arrive in Munich, Germany
- Meet Grand Classroom guide at baggage claim
- Travel to Nuremberg
- Sightseeing with your guide
- Dinner as a group
- Overnight in hotel

Day Two

- See the Nazi Rally Grounds
- Visit the Documentation Center
- Visit the Nuremberg Imperial Castle including Kaiserberg and Burggrafenburg
- Dinner as a group
- Overnight in hotel

Day Three

- Travel to Garmisch-Partenkirchen
- Visit the site of the 1936 Winter Olympics and tour the historic ski Jump
- Free time exploring town
- Travel to Innsbruck, Austria – Capital of the Alps
- Dinner as a group
- Overnight in hotel

Day Four

- Travel to Bolzano, Italy
- Explore Firmian Castle and learn about Italy's role in WWII and the South Tyrolean autonomy
- Dinner as a group
- Return to Innsbruck
- Overnight in hotel

Day Five

- Morning walking tour of Innsbruck with discussions on historical memories of WWII in the city
- Travel to Salzburg
- Tour the city highlighting classical and modern history in Old Town
- See the massive Festung Hohensalzburg
- Dinner as a group
- Overnight in hotel

Day Six

- Tour Mauthausen Memorial Camp – the largest concentration camp in Europe
- Guided tour of the Altaussee salt mine where invaluable pieces of stolen art were stored
- Dinner as a group
- Overnight in hotel

Day Seven

- Travel to Berchtesgarden
- Tour Hitler's Eagle's Nest in the Bavarian Alps
- Travel to Munich for free time touring the city, exploring galleries, and learning about Bavaria
- Dinner as a group
- Overnight in hotel

Day Eight

- Explore the guided Third Reich tour of Munich -See Marienplatz, Odeonplatz, Nationaltheater, and the Isator as you learn about the crucial role of the city of Munich in WWII
- Explore Nymphenburg Palace
