

We hope you will find this information helpful when making travel arrangements for your child for the 2021-22 school year.

Saturday, November 20 Academic classes will end by 11 am. Students may depart campus following their last class. *Varsity teams qualifying for New England tournaments may have games during this time.*

Dormitories will close by 4 pm on November 20.

Monday, November 29 Boarding students must return to campus by 8:00 p.m. School obligations begin Tuesday, November 30.

Dormitories will open at noon.

Friday, December 17 Student obligations will be done by 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 16 (following Lessons and Carols and community dinner). Students may depart after this service or before noon on Friday, December 17. *Some varsity winter teams may be playing in tournaments during this weekend.*

Dormitories will close by 3:00 p.m.

Monday, January 3 Boarding students must return to campus by 8:00 p.m. School obligations begin Tuesday, January 4.

Dormitories will open at noon.

Saturday, January 22 Winter Term activities will end by Friday, January 21. Afternoon activities will be done by early evening Saturday, January 22. A student may depart after their last obligation for the weekend. Dorms will remain open through the weekend.

A boarding student leaving for the weekend must return to campus by 8:00 p.m. Monday, January 24.

Saturday, March 5 Academic classes will end by noon. Students may depart campus following their last class.

Dormitories will close by 4 pm on March 5.

Wednesday, March 23 Boarding students must return to campus by 8:00 p.m. School obligations begin Thursday, March 24.

Dormitories will open at noon.

Monday, May 30

Graduates will depart campus following Prize Day, no later than 3:00 p.m.

Friday, June 3

Students may depart campus after their last academic obligation.

Students taking the SAT at Brooks, or students with flight arrangements for Saturday morning will be allowed to stay on campus, with deans' permission, until Saturday.

Dormitories will close for the summer on Saturday, June 4 by 3:00 p.m.

We understand that sometimes there will be conflicts with our schedule and an individual's travel plans. However, permission to leave early or return late from school breaks must be obtained from the Dean of Students. Missing any classes due to an early departure or late return from a break will count toward a student's attendance record.
